Dear Residents, Relatives and Friends,

We want to provide you with an update following the recent COVID confirmed cases in Victoria. Authorities have identified over 40 primary close contacts of the **3 confirmed cases in Victoria** and extensive contact tracing is underway. If you have visited or been in direct contact with anyone who visited any of the locations in the table below during the date indicated, **you must get tested** and isolate until you get a negative result. Do not visit Fairway until you can provide written clearance (negative result).

These premises have had confirmed cases visit during their infectious period.

## VISITING FAIRWAY

**Effective 1<sup>st</sup> January 2021, we ask that visitation is only for the purposes of providing essential care and support necessary for the resident's emotional, cultural, spiritual, or social wellbeing that cannot reasonably be provided via electronic means.**

You can visit anytime between **11am – 2pm, Monday to Sunday.**

All visitors **must adhere** to the following safety measures when visiting Fairway:

- Clean and sanitise your hands before entry and during your visit.
- Complete Fairway Visitor Declaration form (electronically via QR code or paper form).
- Temperature check upon entry.
- Fairway will **supply a new mask** upon entry to the facility. Fitted masks must be worn by all visitors.
- Sign in and out of Visitors book. Visitors are required to write the time they enter and leave the facility.
- Visitors **cannot access** the internal communal spaces such as the lounge. Visits must be in the resident's room or garden.
- Practice social distancing of 1.5 metres at all times.
- **DO NOT VISIT IF YOU ARE FEELING UNWELL.**
- We encourage visitors to provide written proof of their recent flu vaccination.

**Residents who want to leave the facility will need to notify Sylvia or myself via email or phone.**

We will review the restrictions regularly as more information about the local COVID cases in Victoria are known.

We ask you to please share this information with your immediate and extended family.
