Fairway update regarding Covid-19

First and foremost, a huge thank you to all family members for your continuing support during these very challenging times.

Following notification on Monday 11th May from Victorian Premier Daniel Andrews, regarding some relaxing of the current state restrictions, effective 14th May residents who attend external medical/hospital appointments or emergency treatment will no longer be required to isolate after their return. You are still required to consult with Allison Kranitz (DON) or Carolyn Rigby / Sue Zaks (CCC) prior to leaving for these appointments.


Current restrictions continue to be in place and visitors/ family members must adhere to the following:

- Visitation time is Monday – Friday, 2-4pm
- Stay at home if you are unwell
- If returning from overseas travel or being in contact with a positive COVID-19 person you must self-quarantine for 14 days
- Follow hand washing requirements and hand sanitising requirements on entry and prior to leaving the facility
- Have your temperature taken and recorded upon entry remains in place.
- Keep visits in a maximum of 2 people at a time.
- No children under 16 years of age are allowed to visit. (exceptional circumstances only, as authorised by DON/CCC)
- Ensure all visits occur only in resident rooms or outside. Please do not gather in communal areas
- Practice social distancing at all times
- Have your seasonal flu shot. Government direction has advised persons who have not been vaccinated will not be able to enter aged care as from 1st May 2020
- Inform us if you get sick after visiting your loved one

Please also be mindful that if you or anyone you see regularly may have had contact with any staff from Cedar Meats Abattoir, please do not visit Fairway.

Please be reassured as we travel through these uncharted waters of Covid-19, the most important focus for us all at Fairway is to keep our residents and staff as safe as we possibly can.
